- Review Minutes from 11-14-2017. Minutes were reviewed and approved.
- Review Student Satisfaction Surveys for Spring 2018. Members are going to review the surveys and report back to chair concerns. Sherry Alexander mentioned that comments that are redundant usually indicate there are valid concerns.
- Review Student Conduct handout. Committee had no questions regarding Student Conduct handout.
- Suggestions to improve Student Satisfaction through Student Affairs. Committee members will email chair comments/concerns.
- Sherry Alexander Comments:
 - NOC Classroom Building is a classroom building, and not a venue to house eating establishments. Sherry emphasized this point because she has had numerous comments voicing concerns that there are no eating establishments in the NOC Building.
 - “Gateway Gives” is a new student organization representing NOC Stillwater.

- Sherry mentioned it is a possibility that NOC freshmen students will be required to live in OSU housing.
- Sherry wants to form a “Campus Safety Task Force” for NOC Stillwater. This task force will initiate a comprehensive plan for safety practices to be implemented by staff and faculty for instances of fire, tornado, and campus shooter. The task force will include NOC employees with representatives from each floor as well as divisionally. The task force will meet with OSU Officer Queen to begin formulation and implementation of safety plans.
- The committee members mentioned that we no longer have the laminated “Safety Practices” in each classroom that was present in Cowboy Mall.
